Hope Center Purchases Permanent Home in Downtown LeRoy, Launches \$400,000 Building Campaign

LeRoy, NY Hope Center, a LeRoy-based nonprofit organization dedicated to providing hope through meaningful community programs, is excited to announce the purchase of its first permanent home at 54–56 Main Street in LeRoy. The organization officially closed on the building on Friday, January 23, marking a major milestone in its history.

Founded in 2017, Hope Center began with a simple but powerful mission: to meet people where they are and provide hope through supportive, inclusive programming. Since its start, Hope Center has operated out of a rented space at 46 Main Street, steadily expanding its reach and impact throughout LeRoy and the greater GLOW region. Over the years, the organization has grown beyond what its current location can accommodate, and the dream of owning a building long felt financially out of reach.

“That dream became a reality thanks to Peter Gallagher, a real estate investor and president of PB ST PETE LLC. Peter stepped forward not only to support the purchase of the building, but also to help make possible a full renovation of the main level!” shares Hope Center director, Gina Lathan.

The newly purchased building, known to many longtime residents as The Economy, later the Hobby Horse Antique Store, and several other businesses in between, will be transformed into a true community center, located right in the heart of downtown LeRoy and the center of the GLOW region. The renovations and build out will take place over the next few months, with a Ribbon Cutting targeted for late summer.

A Space Designed for Community Impact

Once renovations are complete, the Hope Center building will include:

- A dedicated Tutoring Center
- A spacious Senior Moments Respite Program area
- Two community event spaces available for gatherings, celebrations, and meetings
- A Community Resource Room including a “little free library”, puzzles, games, books and health, wellness, and hopeful living resources
- A certified kitchen

- Office and meeting rooms available for rent

This expanded space will allow Hope Center to grow and strengthen each of its core programs:

- Fresh Start Tutoring will benefit from a dedicated, welcoming learning environment designed to better support students and tutors.
- Senior Moments Respite Program will have increased space to serve families of loved ones living with Alzheimer's and dementia, with safety, comfort, dignity, and flexibility.
- Made To Bloom: Women's Health & Wellness programming will expand with room for workshops, support groups, and wellness-focused gatherings.
- Men of Hope Community Outreach will have space to grow mentorship, connection, and outreach opportunities.

"Our new building allows us to expand not just our space, but our impact," Lathan shares. "It gives us the ability to dream bigger, serve more people, and respond to the evolving needs of our community."
